Why it Won't Happen

Many legislatures are weak and compromised Many regulators are under-empowered, under-resourced Many regulators are subject to capture

2. <u>Legal, Organisational and Technical</u> Measures need to be Combined

- L Weak laws and their implications need to be exposed, with concrete (preferably heart-rending) examples
- O Self-regulation needs to be studied in detail, and its inadequacies clearly documented
- The gaps in protections need to be addressed by making tools available to protect activists:
 - Obfuscate and falsify data, messages, identities, locations and social networks
 - "Avoid, distort, block and break surveillance"



3. Civil Society Needs to Capture the Moral High Ground

NGOs are marginalised by Standards-setting processes NGOs need to promulgate **Public Standards**, to compete with business and government Standards NGOs need to then evaluate technologies, applications, practices and laws against those Public Standards

Examples: A proper process for impact assessment

4. Relevant Academic Research is Challenging and is continually challenged by opponents

- Emergent phenomena are unstable, so reliable empirical data is impossible to attain
- Contexts are complex, Attitudes are contingent
- 'What people say they do is not what they do'
- Research that addresses the interests of people is deprecated as 'agenda-driven', biassed, unreliable
- Research that reflects current values / the *status quo* is perceived to be appropriate and responsible
